2. The meeting was called to order at 2204 EST by the Chair.

3. Reports

- a. MER. Reported discussion of budget cuts, as well as the region cadet competition.
- b. GLR. Reported on their region cadet competition as well as wing encampments within their region.
- c. RMR. Discussed region review of recruiting incentives.
- d. SWR. Discussed RCLS, region cadet competition, and recruiting pamphlets being discussed at the region.
- e. NCR. Announced proposals for open floor, as well as reviewed region cadet competition.
- f. Chair. Discussed the uniform issues and progress of draft CAPR 52-16 at the National Board held in Washington D.C.
- g. Senior. Stated that the NCAC is very well heard and is doing a fine job.

4. New Business

- a. Appointment of Next Chair (Chair). It was announced that, due to the current chair turning 21, C/Lt Col Jamie Hurley (SWR) will be taking over as Acting Chair on 26 Mar 2006.
- b. Position Paper on Magazine (GLR). C/Lt Col Koehler presented a paper by the GLR CAC regarding the *Civil Air Patrol Volunteer*. GLR brought up that the new *Volunteer* magazine has a substantial loss in materials such as Milestone Achievement listings and Region Reports.

C/Lt Col Rehman stated that the working committee (of which he is a member) which created the magazine decided to only print the top two cadet and senior awards, for cost reasons. The council elected to draft a memo expressing their concern on these issues, which will be given to C/Lt Col Hurley to deliver to the working committee. C/Lt Col Koehler will prepare the memo by the April meeting.

- c. Position Paper on CAC Ribbon. (GLR) C/Lt Col Koehler presented a paper by the GLR CAC advocating that senior members be allowed to wear the CAC Ribbon earned as a cadet. The council agreed, stating that both the level of dedication required to serve actively on CAC, and the benefit of the CAC, should be recognized at the senior member level.

However, most of the other service-related cadet awards, such as the Encampment and NCSA Ribbons, may be earned as a senior member. Therefore, the council elected to also propose that senior members who serve as CAC Advisors should be able to earn the CAC Ribbon with appropriate device. C/Lt Col Koehler will modify and present a new memo at the April meeting.

5. Old Business

- a. National Cadet Competition Revised Paper (Chair/GLR). Not all of the council members had been able to take a look over the revisions. The council elected to hold an electronic vote on the paper so that everyone could be adequately informed.
  - b. Position Paper on Program Cuts (Chair). The Chair reported that there have been no budget cuts to NCSAs or IACE at this time. Therefore, it was decided to table the memo regarding the cadet standpoint on these cuts.
  - c. Recruiting Goal (CAP/CC). The recruiting goal was tabled until the next meeting; C/Col Smith, who heads the committee, was not present at the meeting.
  - d. Retaining 16 – 17 Year Old Cadet Percentages (NHQ). C/Maj Imbriale was not present to share comments from the NCAC's Leadership Development Committee.
6. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for 02 April 2006 from 200-2100 Central Standard Time.
7. The meeting was adjourned at 2245 EST by the Chair.
