This is a closed-book test and no study materials may be present on the cadet's desk/table.

MP 2 Begin the test.

MP 3 Each cadet upon completion will return the test and answer sheet to the instructor.

MP 4 The test will be graded as soon as possible. The passing score is seventy (70) percent. The unit commander may allow the test to be corrected to one hundred (100) percent (CAPR 52-16, Paragraph 2-4d).
