Introduction

Conclusion

SUMMARY: We have reviewed the material that you learned when you studied during Phase III.

REMOTIVATION: It is important that you take advantage of these reviews so you will pass the Amelia Earhart Award Test with flying colors. Passing the Amelia Earhart Award Test will make you eligible to become a Phase IV cadet.
