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### PART II TEACHING PLAN

#### Introduction

**TRANSITION:** The instructor will review the material in *Leadership: 2000 and Beyond*, beginning with an overview of the subject matter followed by a discussion of the review questions for each chapter. If the cadets have other questions relating to the material being discussed, encourage the cadets to ask the question at any time.

#### Body

**NOTE:** Each cadet's CAPF 55a, *Request for Examination*, requesting the General Carl A. Spaatz Award test should be sent to the Wing Liaison Office and a test date scheduled for Week 15. The instructor will use the review questions in the leadership material to aid in the discussion and review of the leadership laboratory material. Use the other material as needed to cover the required items.
